- 2. Managing the operations of the radiation area assigned to ensure judicious radiation protection and optimum patient care.
- 3. Supervising staff assigned to the area.
- 4. Monitoring levels of stock and sundries within the area.

- 5. Monitoring performance of imaging equipment within the area.
- 6. Conducting performance evaluations of staff assigned.
- 7. Liaising with ward/clinic staff and other Heads of Departments to ensure optimum operations between departments.
- 8. Liaising with maintenance contractors and associated companies to ensure regular preventive maintenance and prompt corrective action
- 9. Supervising and instructing students/interns assigned on clinical rotation.
- 10. Compiling statistical data associated with the department.
- 11. Budgeting for the needs and requirements of the department.
- 12. Other associated duties within the span of control of the post.
