### JOB PURPOSE

Under the direction of the Treatment Facility Manager, the incumbent is responsible to operate the waste collection vehicles and perform day-to-day operation and routine maintenance of the collection vehicles in an efficient manner and in compliance with the operations, maintenance, and health and safety plans of the waste treatment facility.

### KEY OUTPUTS

### **KEY RESPONSIBILITY AREAS**

- 1. Ensure that medical waste containers are collected daily from healthcare facilities according to Collection Guidelines and Schedules.
- 2. Conduct loading and unloading of medical waste storage containers at healthcare facilities and the treatment facility respectively, according to Standard Operating Procedures.
- 3. Drive and operate the treatment facility collection vehicles and waste storage containers per operations manuals.
- 4. Perform routine preventative maintenance checks and light repairs to collection vehicles and waste storage containers according to the Maintenance Plan and Procedures Manual.
- 5. Perform other corrective maintenance procedures as directed by Treatment Facility Manager.
- 6. Monitor the collection vehicles maintenance service schedule and notify the Facility's Manager to ensure that the collection vehicles receives timely servicing.
- 7. Monitor stocks of consumables, emergency response kits and personal protective equipment, and advise Treatment Facility Manager to facilitate timely procurement and ensure continuous availability.
- 8. Perform inspection of waste manifest forms for waste collected from healthcare facilities to ensure accuracy of information reported.

- 9. Report and document all accidental spills, emergencies and equipment malfunctions occurring during collection and transportation.
- 10. Perform sanitation duties of collection vehicles using mechanical washing unit per schedule.
- 11. Administer basic safety and emergency response procedures according to Safety and Emergency Response Plans, when necessary.
- 12. Advise the Treatment Facility Manager of all equipment malfunctions to ensure timely execution of corrective actions.

#### **Other Responsibilities**

13. Perform other job related functions so assigned or as necessary to maintain the performance standards of the facility

#### PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

- 1. Medical waste storage containers collected from healthcare facilities according to established schedules.
- 2. High compliance level with vehicle operations and maintenance procedures established and maintained
- 3. Collection vehicles operated with minimum downtime.
- 4. Collection vehicles receive scheduled maintenance and servicing within established timeframes.
- 5. Waste manifest forms accurately completed and submitted on schedule.
- 6. Adequate stock of consumables, spare parts and personal protective equipment maintained on collection vehicles to ensure the efficient operation and maintenance activities.
- 7. Collection vehicles and waste storage containers properly sanitized and available for use within the established timeframes.
- 8. Safety and emergency response procedures implemented according to Safety and Emergency Response Plans and within established timeframe.
- 9. Adherence to the Facility's Safety and Health Plans.

10. All relevant records maintained and reported within established timeframe (waste manifest, accidental spills, emergencies, and vehicle malfunctions and maintenance activities, records).
